

Beach Ultimate

Beach Ultimate is a fast growing and exciting sport. Teams of 5 players try to score points by receiving the flying disc (Frisbee) in the endzone of the opponent (similar to American Football).

Movement of the disc and the players


The disc can be thrown from one player to another in any direction. A player may not run with the disc in hand. The person with the disc in hand has 10 seconds to throw the disc to a teammate.

Change of possession

A turnover (i.e. defense takes possession of the disc and becomes offense) results whenever one of the following items occur:

- the disc touches the ground (also when first touched by the defense)
- the disc is caught outside the field (line is out)
- the disc is intercepted by an opposing player





Scoring

A goal, worth 1 point, is scored when a player throws the disc to a teammate and it is successfully caught in the endzone of the other team. Games are 45 minutes or until a team reaches 13 points

Player substitutions

A player can only be substituted after a score was made and the teams are lining up, or if a player is injured. No other substitutions can take place while the point is in progress.

Non-contact

Beach Ultimate is a non-contact sport and when a player initiates contact on another player a foul is committed.

Self-Refereeing

All fouls are called by the player(s) involved. When a foul results in loss of possession, the play is stopped and resumed as if possession was not lost. If the player committing the foul disagrees with the foul call, the play is redone.



Spirit of the Game

Beach Ultimate is about sportsmanship and fair play. Competitive play is encouraged, but never at the expense of respect between players, adherence to the rules, or the basic joy of play.

The European Championships are comprised of round robin pool play, with 4 pools of four teams, for each division. All teams participating are Beach Ultimate champions of their country, or in a few cases the runners up. Teams were seeded based on final standings of the 2017 World Championships of Beach Ultimate for national teams in Royan, France.

The playoff system includes Pre-Quarters, Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals/Placement games. The crossover round (Pre-Quarter) involves all teams and is aimed at correcting potential seeding errors.




